Getting to Know Us

What is the Chapter all About?

The "Chapter" is the single most important benefit of GWRRA because we make friends, ride our Gold Wings, promote safe riding, enhance our motorcycle experience and learn skills and safety techniques for rides.

What are those pins on people's vest?

Those are Ride or Event Pins. Every time a chapter puts on a Poker Run or other special events are held, like a District Rally, usually a ride pin is available, and is sometimes included in the cost of registration. The pins are basically souvenirs that are fun to look back on for memories each represent. HINT: The pins provide an easy way to meet and converse with the person.

What is a poker Run?

A Poker Run serves as a fund raising activity. There is usually a charge for each poker hand, which serves as a donation to the District. Each Poker Run may differ in one way or another, but are basically as follows: We sign in and get a set of directions to a check point. When we arrive at the first checkpoint we draw a playing card. We continue on to the second and subsequent checkpoints, until we reach the final point. The high hand will win a prize or share in the funds collected from the event.

What is the Ride for Kids?

The Pediatric Brain Tumor Foundation is a non-profit, charitable foundation, supported by the national Ride For Kids program. Their goal is to find the cause and cure for childhood brain tumors through medical research and increase public awareness. The local Ride for Kids takes place annually, in Sacramento, the first weekend in October. There are 600-800 participants on this ride, all riding together, non-stop for 60 miles with police escorts. PBTFUS, and their Ride For Kids event, is a charity we are all extremely proud to help support.
